- Never force your child to take part in rowing.
- Set a good example by recognising fair competition and applauding the good performances of all.
- Never punish or belittle a child for losing or making mistakes.
- Publicly accept officials' judgements.
- Support your child's involvement and help them to enjoy their rowing.
- Use correct and proper language at all times.
- Refrain from smoking whilst on the Club premises and at events.
- Refrain from adult humour and discussion of adult subjects.
- Do not engage in any physical contact with non-family members of the Junior squad.
